

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING TO THE DUAL-DEGREE MANAGEMENT AND TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM**

1. Applications to The Jerome Fisher Program in Management & Technology will only be considered after completion of eight course units minimum, usually at the end of the freshman year, at the University of Pennsylvania.
2. A student wishing to pursue this dual-degree program must develop a study plan with the aid of advisors in both the School of Engineering and Applied Science and the Wharton School.
3. The student must submit the following information to the Management and Technology Office:
  - The M&T/Dual-Degree Application
  - The University Dual-Degree application
  - A completed SEAS Worksheet and a completed M&T/Wharton Worksheet with signatures from advisors in both school (you will find these worksheets in PennInTouch)
  - Personal essay (no more than 2 pages)
  - Two letters of recommendation from Penn faculty (recommendations should be confidential and can mailed or emailed ([mgtech@seas.upenn.edu](mailto:mgtech@seas.upenn.edu)) to the M&T Office)

ALL application materials must be submitted together no later than May 1 to the Management and Technology Office at 3537 Locust Walk. The M&T Review Committee will review your application, and you will be notified over the summer if you have been admitted to the program. In case of a denial, you may indicate at the bottom of the application if you wish to be considered subsequently for dual-degree status.

### **Minimum Requirements**

- Minimum G.P.A. of 3.4
- Prerequisite courses:
  - ➔ Math 104 & 114
  - ➔ Economics 1 & 2 or Economics 010 & BPUB 250
  - ➔ Physics 140/150 or CSE 110, EE 115, or CSE 120/130
