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- ▶ Finding a job is really marketing your PhD work

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- ▶ Best place to find academic hiring ads is the CRA website (just Google "CRA Job Announcements")

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- ▶ Pay special attention to who is hiring in your field - they are more likely to interview you than a school doing general search
- ▶ Also take your personal situation into account
- ▶ For example, if you have a two-body problem to solve, you have to apply to many more places - I applied to over 70!

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- ▶ Teaching statement: address teaching interests and philosophy, but research schools won't pay much attention

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- ▶ No one should come out of the talk without having a clear idea of why your research is important

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- ▶ Revise your talk based on feedback from practice talk

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- ▶ Job interview not an exam, but an **opportunity** to meet interesting colleagues and potential future collaborators
- ▶ Be yourself, don't obsess about impressing others!
