2. NOTES ON JMP

2.1. Opening JMP

The following notes are intended for users of JMP on machines in the Towne Building. JMP can be accessed (in Windows 10) by the menu sequence:

Start
$$\rightarrow$$
 JMP 14 \rightarrow JMP 14 PRO

Once you are in JMP you can access the class data sets and simulation exercises in the directory:

All such data sets can be downloaded (as JMP files) or copied into your own ENIAC directory. They can also be exported as .txt files from inside JMP by the following procedure:

File
$$\rightarrow$$
 Save As \rightarrow [Menu Options]

In the **Save As** Menu, check the **Text Format** option [notice that this automatically gives the filename a **.TXT** extension]. Next click **Text Options** ... and you will see that there are many options which you can use for saving (such as including column **labels** from the data set in JMP and selecting various types of spacing and ending conventions).

Note finally that there are copies of the **JMP manual** both in the Lab and in the Towne Library.
